Prepared by Elonda Clay, M.L.S. for the American Theological Library Association.

This bibliography contains printed materials and online resources in cross-cultural ministry. The focus is on intercultural dynamics in both global missions and urban missions within the United States. This resource was completed in December 2001 and designed for persons who are engaged in cross-cultural ministry or theological seminary studies.

Note: The subsection "Race and Reconciliation" deals with issues of racism inside the church and in theological interpretation.

Publication dates range from the year 2002 to 1979. The materials are arranged alphabetically by author within each timeline. Also provided are search terms that the bibliographer found useful.
